



Kalasin University Announcement

No gift policy and favors while completing duties.

Fiscal year B.E. 2568 (2025)

Kalasin University is committed to upholding a strict policy against accepting gifts and any form of gratification, both before and after the completion of duties. This stance reflects our unwavering opposition to all forms of corruption and misconduct, while also strengthening the organizational culture and values of honesty, morality, and ethics. There is no conflict of interest in performing duties and preventing corruption, ensuring transparency and adherence to the principles of good governance.

In accordance with Section 31 of the Kalasin University Act, B.E. 2558, the following provisions are hereby announced:

1. All administrators and personnel of Kalasin University are prohibited from accepting gifts or favors from individuals or entities associated with the university.
2. All administrators and personnel of Kalasin University are prohibited from offering gifts or favors to individuals or entities associated with the university.
3. All administrators and personnel of Kalasin University are prohibited from accepting any form of unlawful benefits.
4. Expressions of congratulations, best wishes, greetings, or condolences on traditional occasions should be conveyed through greeting cards, books, condolence cards, or social media, rather than through gifts.
5. All administrators and personnel of Kalasin University have a responsibility to thoroughly inform outsiders regarding the policy.

This announcement is to be acknowledged and adhered to by all parties involved.
